## Ten ways to improve your site's accessibility

- 1. **Put good text with your photos -** Include strong alternative text
- 2. **Facilitate screen reader navigation –** Use heading labels, give links labels and make them descriptive, incorporate skip links
- 3. **Write heads-up headlines –** Warn readers of alternative story formats
- 4. **Offer alternative delivery options –** Social media, newsletters
- 5. **Use good video/audio players –** Have labeled buttons and the option to view full-screen
- 6. **Simplify layouts and reduce clutter –** Don't split articles across pages, and reduce redundant and distracting linking
- 7. **Be careful with advertisements –** Keep them out of the way, and avoid Flash and pop-ups
- 8. **Get rid of CAPTCHAs –** Try riddles or confirmation emails instead
- **9. Offer a mobile site –** And keep it simple
